Rules & Regulations

1. **All work** must be original, handcrafted, created and exhibited by the artist themselves. Kits, imports, and mass-produced items will be not accepted. This rule is strictly enforced.
2. All categories will be reviewed and screened prior to your acceptance. Any media NOT approved during the application process that appears in your booth at the event will be removed.
3. All applications require 3 photos of your work plus 1 photo of your booth.
4. Displays must be professional and aesthetically pleasing. Handwritten signs and sale signs are strictly prohibited. The goal is to make your tent/area look like a 'mini' art gallery.
5. Although the show is not juried, a panel of 'judges' will evaluate applicants' artwork according to quality, mastery of medium, and originality.
6. Each exhibitor is responsible for collecting and remitting local sales tax to the State's Department of Revenue as required by law.
